18.	What is relevant date of revision of Electoral Roll?	The relevant date of revision of Electoral Roll is 1 <sup>st</sup> January of the Year in which the roll is finally published.
19.	What is an Overseas (NRI) Elector?	Indian Citizens living outside of the country for work, education or any other reason are categorized as overseas (NRI) electors. Such non-resident Indian are qualified as electors only, if they have not required any other Country's Citizenship.
20.	What is NOTA?	NOTA Means None of the above. This would allow voters, who do not consider any of the candidates eligible to still cast their votes.
